Frequently Asked Questions about Fair Entries

1. "Who can enter items in the Beltrami County Fair?"

Anyone can enter items in the Open Classes. Only 4-H members may enter items in 4H classes.

2. "What is an Open Class?"

Open Class is just that: open for entry by anyone who has created an item or has an animal that meets the class and lot description. The item must be the work of the person entering it. It is not acceptable to enter a gift you received or a purchased item. Animal entries must be owned by the entrant.

3. "Is there a fee to enter?"

There is no fee to enter an exhibit in the Open Class areas.

4."How do I enter?"

You or someone you designate must bring the item/s or animal/s to the fairgrounds. Come to the Barn or Exhibit area designated for the Department. Intake volunteers will take your entry and put an exhibit ticket on it and give you a claim stub.

4. "How do I know what can be entered?"

This Premium Book tells about the fair - the whats and whens. It also contains lists. Lists of Open Classes and 4-H classes. The lists in the Open Class give the classes and lots for entries. If your item or animal fits something that is listed in an Open Class it can be entered. If you have questions about where an item fits or need other information related to exhibits contact the Department Superintendent or area coordinator. If you are entering animals check with the Department Superintendent to see what shots and health certificates may be required. Pre-registration is encouraged for Home Arts and Horticulture exhibits and required for livestock exhibits.

5. "What if my item does not fit anything in the lists?"

Most of the classes have a lot called "Not Specified". If your item would go in a class but there is no specific lot that fits it, enter it in the Not Specified lot. Work that does not fit in the classes may be exhibited but will not be judged. The Home Arts Department welcomes such exhibits; if these new exhibits create interest we may add that type item to next year's judged exhibits.

6. "Does every entry get a ribbon?"

KIDS AREA of each class are the only lots in the Open Classes where every entry gets a ribbon. SO--If your child is making an entry and you want the child to get a ribbon- MAKE SURE to enter the item in a KIDS AREA lot. All entries in KIDS AREAS get a participation ribbon. In general Open Class lots, ribbons will only go to the top three exhibits.

7. "Do I get money if I win a ribbon?"

Yes. The prize money for a ribbon is called the premium. Premium award amounts for Blue - Red - and White are listed with the lots. There are no monetary awards for purple ribbons or participation ribbons. There are some special awards from businesses or guilds that award moneygift certificates- or special prizes.

8. "When Can I pick up my item?"

The items you enter must remain at the Fair and will be on exhibit until the last day of the Fair. There will be a specific time to pick up entries and premiums won on the last day. Usually it is from 5-7pm. Bring the claim stub from each entry ID tag to pick up you items.

Frequently Asked Questions about Judging of Open Class Exhibits

1. Can I watch the judging?

The Open Class exhibit areas in the Home Arts and Horticulture Departments are closed during judging. To keep the entries anonymous the names are covered on the ID tickets during judging. Only the judge and several helpers complete the judging process and pin ribbons on the winners.

2. Can I help with the judging?

Possibly. To run the fair takes lots of volunteers. Volunteers are needed to help with judging as well as with other parts of the exhibits. Come to a Fair Board meeting or contact the Department Superintendent if you want to help.

3. Who does the judging?

The Fair Board looks for people with knowledge and expertise in the areas being judged. The judges may change from year to year. It depends on availability. Judges do not make entries in any areas they judge.

4. What judging system is used?

The American judging system is used. This judging process ranks exhibits one against another and awards 1 first place, 1second place, and 1 third place only. Judges may withhold awards in any lot if, in their opinion, no exhibit is worthy. This rarely occurs as most entries are well made. In lots where there are more than three entries some entries will not receive ribbons. Most entries are very good, but only the three top entries receive ribbons.

- **Pre-registration greatly speeds up entry time.** Registrations must be postmarked by the Friday before the fair!

Home Arts General Rules

- All articles must be made by the exhibitor and not previously displayed at the Beltrami County Fair.
- Carefully follow instructions as to size, quantity and presentation of exhibits located at the beginning of each section. Questions- call the Supervisor of that Section. We are happy to help.
- Limit of one entry per exhibitor in any lot.
- When two levels exist, entry can only be made in the advanced lot **or** the Beginner lot, not in both.
- Bring items for entry to Home Arts area between the hours of 5:00 pm and 8:00 pm on Tuesday, or noon to 4 pm on Wednesday of fair week. No mailed items accepted. If someone else brings the items, have an information card attached to each item with class and lot clearly identified.
- All items entered, remain on exhibit until closing time on Sunday afternoon. Claim tickets will be given when the item is entered and must be presented during pick up time to claim your item and award. No early release of items.
- The American judging system is used. This judging system ranks exhibits one against another and awards one first place, one second place, and one third place. The judges may withhold awards in any lot if, in their opinion, no exhibit is worthy.
- Every item in competition must correspond in number and description with the award list and be entered in the proper class. No changes or alterations shall be permitted after entry time is closed.
- Items not in the premium list may be exhibited at the discretion of the Superintendent, but will not be considered for premiums. The Home Arts Department welcomes such exhibits; if the items create interest, we may add it as a new category to next year's judged exhibits.
- All items are entered and show at the risk of the owners. While all reasonable care will be taken in the handling and protection of exhibits, the officials will in no case be responsible for any damage or loss.

GENERAL INFORMATION

There have been many changes, additions, and/or deletions from past years, so it is important to read through the premium list carefully.

This area is for home gardeners only – persons who earn a living selling produce are excluded.

-Exhibitors should keep in mind that attractiveness of displays and exhibits is important.

-Gently remove dirt from all vegetables

-All entries should be uniform in size, shape and color

-Root crops – trim tops to 1-1 1/2" above crown, trim side roots

-Cabbage – cut stem ¼" below head

-Watermelon, winter squash, pumpkins - leave 1"of stem,

-Peppers - leave 1/2 - 1" of stem

-Celery – trim butt to form triangle or pyramid

-Rhubarb - trim leaves to 2" above leaf stalk

-Onions - trim roots to 1/2", tops to 1-2", do not peel

-Tomatoes – do not remove stems

-Apples, cherries, plums - leave stems on

-Show sweet corn in husks.

-If known, indicate the variety names of your exhibits. Judging reflects how well a specimen exhibits characteristics of a named variety.

Garden displays must be arranged by the exhibitor and attractiveness and beauty of the exhibit will be considered in judging. Avoid putting in freaks or oversized vegetables. Remember that the food value and variety of vegetables and fruits in the exhibit, as well as the quality, will be the basis on which these displays are judged.

Entries must be submitted between the hours of 12 noon and 7 p.m. on entry day, Wednesday, and must be picked up at 5 p.m. on the final day of the fair. <u>Please note that Home Arts has</u> <u>different hours – check their premium list for times!!</u> Pre-registration greatly speeds up the entry process. Exhibitors with a large number of exhibits are encouraged to arrive early to avoid congestion. Late entries will not be accepted. All exhibitors are asked to come prepared with written entry information appropriate to category.



PRE-REGISTRATION

All livestock entries must be **PRE-REGISTERED** with the department superintendent no later than one week prior to entry day.

NEW THIS YEAR:

All cattle, swine, sheep and goats need to be tagged with the official Minnesota 41 tags unless they are registered animals that are tattooed and the registration papers accompany the animal.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Livestock and poultry that exhibit symptoms of any infectious or communicable disease, including ringworm and warts, may not be exhibited. All animals must be examined by the official veterinarian on the day they are admitted to the exhibition and at least once daily during the exhibitions. All imported animals must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection and meet the Board's importation requirements.

SHEEP and GOATS: All sheep and goats, including wethers, must be identified with official identification approved for use in the scrapie eradication program.

SWINE: Swine must be individually identified and must: (1) have had a negative official pseudorabies test conducted within 30 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition or (2) originate directly from a qualified pseudorabies-negative herd; or (3) originate directly form a Stage IV or V county or area. All 50 states are currently pseudorabies Stage V (Pseudorabies Free Status)

HORSES: All horses must be negative to an official test for Equine Infectious anemia (EIA) within 12 months prior to the opening date of the exhibition. A test is not required for suckling foals accompanying a negative dam.

POULTRY: Poultry, except waterfowl and pigeons, must be individually identified with a leg or wing band and accompanied by a form approved by the board to show compliance with one of the following: negative test for pullorum-typhoid disease conducted within 90 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition; originate directly from parent stock tested and found negative for pullorum-typhoid disease within the last 12 months. In addition, turkeys must be tested negative or originate directly from parent stock that is tested negative for *Salmonella typhimurium, Mycoplasma gallesepticum*, and *Mycoplasma synoviae*.

DOGS: Dogs over six months of age must be accompanied by a certificate of rabies vaccination issued by a licensed veterinarian.
